












Note how each Egyptian false god is countered by GOD with a related plague or judgement.

<b>JUDGEMENT CYCLE 1</b>	<b>HAPI</b> was the god of the annual flooding of the Nile in ancient Egyptian religion.		<b>1 BLOOD</b> The Water of the Nile River turned into Blood!	<b>AARON</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 7:14-25</b>
	<b>HEKET</b> was the goddess of childbirth and fertility in Ancient Egypt. Depicted as a woman with a head of a Frog.		<b>2 FROGS</b> Frogs came out of the Nile River.	<b>AARON</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 8:1-15</b>
	<b>GEB</b> - Egyptian God of the Earth. Geb was the husband and brother of the sky goddess Nut.		<b>3 LICE</b> Lice came from the dust of the earth.	<b>AARON</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 8:16-19</b>
<b>JUDGEMENT CYCLE 2</b>	<b>KHEPRI</b> was connected with the scarab beetle, because the scarab rolls balls of dung across the ground, an act that the Egyptians saw as a symbol of the forces that move the sun across the sky.		<b>4 FLIES</b> Swarms of Flies filled the houses of the Egyptians.	<b>GOD</b>	-	<b>Exodus 8:20-32</b>
	<b>HATHOR</b> Goddess of Love and Protection Possibly a predynastic cult which venerated fertility, and nature in general, represented by cows.		<b>5 CATTLE DIE</b> Death of all the Egyptian Cattle and Livestock.	<b>GOD</b>	-	<b>Exodus 9:1-7</b>
	<b>ISIS</b> was worshipped as the ideal mother and wife as well as the patroness of nature and magic. She was the friend of slaves, sinners, artisans and the downtrodden		<b>6 BOILS</b> Ashes turn into Boils and Sores on all the Egyptians.	<b>MOSES</b>	-	<b>Exodus 9:8-12</b>

	<b>SETH</b> was the brother of Isis and Osiris, and like them he was the son of the sky goddess. Seth is the god of chaos, storms, & disorder.		<b>8 LOCUSTS</b> Locusts came in and ate up all of the Egyptian food crops.	<b>MOSES</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 10:1-20</b>
	<b>RA</b> One of the most important deities in Egyptian mythology, the sun god Ra (or Re) was the supreme power in the universe. The giver of life		<b>9 DARKNESS</b> Thick Darkness in Egypt for a full Three Days.	<b>MOSES</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 10:21-29</b>
<b>DEATH</b>	<b>PHARAOH</b> , the king of Egypt, was worshipped by the Egyptians because he was considered to be the greatest Egyptian God of all. It was believed that he was actually the son of Ra himself, manifest in the flesh.		<b>10 DEATH</b> Death to all the Firstborn in Egypt of <u>Any nationality in Egypt was affected.</u>	<b>GOD</b>	YES	<b>Exodus 11:1-10; 12:29-32</b>
