

The Rapture Clause...

What to do when you realize that you have been Left Behind?

#1 - Accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior. Bow down on your knees right now!

Romans 10:9-13 says, "If you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. **10** For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. **11** For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame." **12** For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. **13** For "whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved."

#2 - Find a Bible and devour it by reading, studying, memorizing and obeying it.

Psalms 119:11, "Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You."

Luke 11:28, "Blessed are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"

2 Timothy 2:15, "Study to show yourself approved to God, a workman who need not be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of truth."

James 1:22, "Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."

#3 - Pray for others; lead many to Christ; preach the gospel; make disciples.

Matthew 28:18-20 Jesus says, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen."

#4 - Do not take the Mark of the Beast, nor worship his image.

Revelation 14:9-12 says, "Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand, **10** "he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. **11** "And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name." **12** Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the word of God and the faith of Jesus."

#5 - Never deny Christ, even if the government wants to kill you for your belief in Him. Do not fear man; fear God!

1 John 4:4 says, "You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

Galatians 5:22-24, "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, **23** gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

24 And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires."

All Eyes on Jerusalem!

When a third Jewish Temple is built and the Jewish sacrifices have begun, then watch and wait for 3-½ years, because a world leader will set himself up in the Jewish temple, proclaiming to be God, and demand to be worshipped as such. (The abomination of desolation).

God's Word promises that you will be blessed if you wait - if you do not worship the image of the beast, nor take his mark, and you make it through to the 1,335 days.

Daniel 12:11-12 says, “And from the time that the daily sacrifice is taken away, and the abomination of desolation is set up, there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days. **12 Blessed is he who waits** and comes to the one thousand three hundred and thirty-five days.”

- **After the rapture of the church**, the Antichrist enters a “PEACE” treaty with Israel. This begins the seven-year tribulation period.
- **At the mid-point of the 7-year tribulation**, 1,260 days later, the Antichrist breaks the treaty, desecrates the temple, demands to be worshipped as God and begins to persecute the Jews.
- **At the end of the tribulation**, 3-½ years, 1,260 days after the desecration of the temple, the abomination of desolation, Jesus Christ returns to earth and defeats the forces of the Antichrist.
- **During the next 30 days** leading up to 1,290 days after the desecration of the temple, Israel is rebuilt and the earth is restored.
- **During the following 45 days** leading up to 1,335 days after the desecration of the temple, the Gentile nations are judged for their treatment of Israel.
- **This point will begin of the millennium reign of Christ** upon the earth. It will last for 1,000 years. See Revelation 20:3, 5–6.
