

1 Samuel 7-8 - "Prepare Your Hearts for the Lord!"
1 Samuel 9-10 - "God Gave Saul a New Heart!"
1 Samuel 11-12 - "Serve the Lord with all Your Heart!"

"With All Your Heart" is found in 21 Bible Verses

1. **Deuteronomy 4:29** But from there you will seek the Lord your God, and you will find Him if you seek Him **with all your heart** and with all your soul.
2. **Deuteronomy 6:5** You shall love the Lord your God **with all your heart**, with all your soul, and with all your strength.
3. **Deuteronomy 10:12** "And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God **with all your heart** and with all your soul,
4. **Deuteronomy 11:13** 'And it shall be that if you earnestly obey My commandments which I command you today, to love the Lord your God and serve Him **with all your heart** and with all your soul,
5. **Deuteronomy 13:3** you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the Lord your God is testing you to know whether you love the Lord your God **with all your heart** and with all your soul.
6. **Deuteronomy 26:16** "This day the Lord your God commands you to observe these statutes and judgments; therefore you shall be careful to observe them **with all your heart** and with all your soul.
7. **Deuteronomy 30:2** and you return to the Lord your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, **with all your heart** and with all your soul,
8. **Deuteronomy 30:6** And the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the Lord your God **with all your heart** and with all your soul, that you may live.
9. **Deuteronomy 30:10** If you obey the voice of the Lord your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this Book of the Law, and if you turn to the Lord your God **with all your heart** and with all your soul.
10. **Joshua 22:5** But take careful heed to do the commandment and the law which Moses the servant of the Lord commanded you, to love the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways, to keep His commandments, to hold fast to Him, and to serve Him **with all your heart** and with all your soul."

11. **1 Samuel 7:3** Then Samuel spoke to all the house of Israel, saying, “If you return to the Lord **with all your hearts**, then put away the foreign gods and the Ashtoreths from among you, and prepare your hearts for the Lord, and serve Him only; and He will deliver you from the hand of the Philistines.”

12. **1 Samuel 12:20** Then Samuel said to the people, “Do not fear. You have done all this wickedness; yet do not turn aside from following the Lord, but serve the Lord **with all your heart**.”

13. **1 Samuel 12:24** Only fear the Lord, and serve Him in truth **with all your heart**; for consider what great things He has done for you.

14. **Proverbs 3:5** Trust in the Lord **with all your heart**, And lean not on your own understanding;

15. **Jeremiah 29:13** And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me **with all your heart**.

16. **Joel 2:12** “Now, therefore,” says the Lord, “Turn to Me **with all your heart**, With fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.”

17. **Zephaniah 3:14** Sing, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O Israel! Be glad and rejoice **with all your heart**, O daughter of Jerusalem!

18. **Matthew 22:37** Jesus said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God **with all your heart**, with all your soul, and with all your mind.”

19. **Mark 12:30** And you shall love the Lord your God **with all your heart**, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment.

20. **Luke 10:27** So he answered and said, “ ‘You shall love the Lord your God **with all your heart**, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind,’ and ‘your neighbor as yourself.’ ”

21. **Acts 8:37** Then Philip said, “If you believe **with all your heart**, you may, (be baptized).” And he answered and said, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God.”

Deuteronomy 10:12-22, “And now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you, but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God **with all your heart** and with all your soul, **13** and to keep the commandments of the Lord and His statutes which I command you today for your good? **14** Indeed heaven and the highest heavens belong to the Lord your God, also the earth with all that is in it. **15** The Lord delighted only in your fathers, to love them; and He chose their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day. **16** Therefore circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and be stiff-necked no longer. **17** For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. **18** He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing. **19** Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt. **20** You shall fear the Lord your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name. **21** He is your praise, and He is your God, who has done for you these great and awesome things which your eyes have seen. **22** Your fathers went down to Egypt with seventy persons, and now the Lord your God has made you as the stars of heaven in multitude.”
